ARGOMENTI SVOLTI

Dal libro di testo “ Into English ” ed. Loescher/Cambridge (vol.1°) sono state svolte le seguenti unità didattiche:

From “ Back into English”:

- **Personal information, family relationships, countries & nationalities, days of the week, months/seasons, times.**
The verb to be (present simple), nationality adjectives. Personal pronouns (subject/object), possessive adjectives, the possessive case, the use of articles (a/an,the), the plural of nouns, irregular plurals, to have got, the alphabet, the spelling, wh- questions. Prepositions of time and place, cardinal and ordinal numbers.
- **Unit 1 “ Out of the Ordinary”**
How to talk about people's daily routine, likes & dislikes, school life
Present simple, use of do/does, frequency adverbs, like+ing form
- **Unit 2 “ Being Useful”**
How to talk about activities happening now.
Present continuous, present continuous vs. present simple, personal pronouns (object)
- **Unit 3 “ Exceptional People”**
Talking about the past (1)
Past tense to be, past tense of regular verbs, use of did / didn't. Past time expressions
- **Unit 4 “ Making Friends”**
Talking about the past (2)
Past tense of regular and irregular verbs
- **Unit 5 “ Getting to the Top”**
Talking about obligation and absence of obligation
Have to /don't have to, must/ mustn't
- **Unit 6 “ Eat for Life”**
Talking about food and drinks, expressing quantities

Countable and uncountable nouns, some/any/no. How much, how many.
Much, many, a lot of.

- **Unit 8 “ Planet Holiday”**
Talking about arrangements
Present continuous as future, future time expressions.
- **Unit 9 “ It'll never happen”**
How to make predictions
Will/won't future. Double future (the future with *as soon as, if, when* + present simple)
- **Unit 11 “ Promises, promises”**
Talking about future intentions, how to make predictions
To be going to.
